# **Chief's Report for Feb & March 2020**

## **Call Reports and Training**

Calls – Medicals & MVA's: 5, Fire: 0

While we have not had many calls so far this quarter, we are prepared. We are keeping abreast of the latest precautions for the coronavirus and will follow precautions as required by the CDC and NorCal EMS.

Training -

- 6 PEFD and 4 LVFD were recertified on CPR, all PEFD personnel are CPR certified.
- 9 PEFD FF's were trained on operation and use of the Air Station and all SCBA's and masks had their batteries replaced.
- 10 PEFD and 2 LVFD were FIT tested for SCBA masks and a Swift Water Awareness presentation was given.
- 6 PEFD attended training on TIC's / CO2 detectors on use and in what situations. Training of proper SCBA don-on and don-off was practiced.
- All formal training has been delayed due to COVID-19. Personnel are encouraged to go online to view training topics.
