Call Reports and Training

Calls – Medicals & MVA's: 4, Fire: 4

We are keeping abreast of the latest precautions for the coronavirus and will continue to follow CDC and NorCal EMS guidelines and requirements.

Training –

- 6/5 - Water sourcing from Hydrants. Practiced Hydrant safety, how to tie off a Hydrant, flush a Hydrant. Long Valley and Engine 311 from the Forest Service were present.
- 6/26 – County wide disaster drill held in Beckwourth. 8 different Fire Departments participated. Hose lays, venting, and search for victims in a structure fire were performed.

Personnel Activity

- Jenni has trained Beckwourth, Sierra Valley, Sierra County FD (Calpine), Forest Service Engine's 311, 312, and 313 in CPR to help them get certified.

Fire Equipment

- 9122 is being prepped for deployment to State and Federal fires.
- A new command vehicle has been purchased through the FEPP program for \$1. It's a White 2008 Chevy Tahoe.

- Need for a smarter more efficient purchasing policy.
- Long Valley is proposing a yearly \$85 increase in their Fire Tax.
