History: The PECSD is responsible for numerous properties and greenbelt within the district. These areas have become a fire danger due to overgrowth of vegetation, downed trees and debris. Background: The District has entered into an agreement with the Feather River Resource Conservation District to address these areas of concern in the district.

Update: PECSD staff has been in contact with Michael Hall from the Feather River Resource Conservation District concerning the status of the project. The crew has been hired and they are waiting on the “go ahead” from the forest service.

Bastian Engineering has completed finding the boundary markers on District property along the river. They have provided the District with maps, which will be passed along to Michael Hall for the project.
