Call Reports and Training

We are keeping abreast of the latest precautions for the coronavirus and will continue to follow CDC and NorCal EMS guidelines and requirements.

Training – Schedule for first 6 months of 2022 completed and distributed.

Personnel Activity

- Jim Heiland resigned.

Fire Equipment

- 9178's future will be determined this winter.
- 9122 has been serviced and steering repaired. Waiting on part for air brakes.
- 12 SCBA's were pressure tested and batteries changed.
- Command vehicle is complete, the old command vehicle will be donated to the Long Valley Fire department.
- Developing plan to make each apparatus more specialized.

Other Activity

- **Burn permits are required and can be received on-line at the Cal Fire website or at the Mohawk Ranger station.** The Air Quality Board determines burn days. Please call (530) 832-4528, press 5 for our region, and listen to the entire message for day designation and instructions.
- Enrolled in FEMA go grant system. Sent in FEMA Grant application, we are asking for 12 new SCBA harness / packs, 12 masks and 12 extra air bottles.
- We are a participant in the OES (MARs) Mutual Aid Reimbursement system. Our F-42 invoice for Pre-Po has been entered and approved, \$46k.
- Received check for \$65k for the Beckwourth Complex Fire.
- Approximately \$262k remain from the Dixie Fire (two deployments).
- Projects on increasing Department revenue, Reflective address numbers for homes on Lundy and older sections, Organizing upstairs Fire supplies.
