

February 2023 Operations Report

Water

- **Flow- Well 1b:** 1,374,700 gallons **Well2:** 0 gallons **Total:** 1,374,700 gallons **Daily Average:** 49,096 gallons.
- **Shutoffs & Leaks:** One leak and shutoff was requested in February.
- **Upcoming Reporting:** As required by the State Water Board, the District will need to submit an Electronic Annual Report (eAR), Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), and the Drought and Conservation Report.

Wastewater

- **Flow- WWTP 6:** 228,744 Gallons; Avg Gal/day 8,169 gallons **WWTP 7:** 1,217,574 gallons Avg Gal/day 43,484 gallons **Total:** 1,446,318 gallons
- **Annual Wastewater & Groundwater Reports:** Staff has been working with Dowl Engineering and providing the needed data for the submission of the two reports. These annual reports are required to be submitted to the State annually to describe the functionality and efficiency of the wastewater system. Both reports have the requirement that an engineer verify the data from the wastewater and groundwater monitoring. Their stamp and signature is required according to the permit issued to District through the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Resources Control Board.

Misc. & Small Projects

- **Snow Removal:** The series of recent storms has kept operational staff very busy removing snow from District roads, office parking lot, treatment facilities, mailbox, and fire hydrants. With the amount of snow received, staff had a difficult time keeping the roads wide enough for emergency vehicles and garbage trucks. An outside contractor was called to help widen the roads using a large front-loader.
